

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Garfield Heights, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Council hereby approves a moratorium with respect to the approval of the construction of billboards within the City of Garfield Heights.
