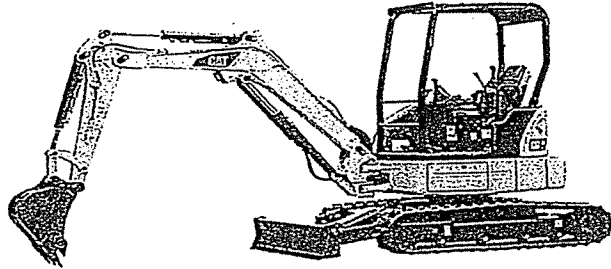

Dear Mayor Burke,

OHM is requesting consideration by the Board of Control for this change order to the Broadway Avenue Watermain Replacement project.

The design and construction related complexities to replace the waterline have grown significantly, as evidenced by the more than \$550,000 increase in the construction cost for this project. These complexities, driven by complicated underground design issues, have required additional engineering design efforts. We are also forecasting additional time required by the contractor to complete the project. And, because our inspection hours are directly associated with the construction schedule, we are forecasting additional inspection costs as well.

For the reasons described above, OHM is submitting this request for the following budget amendment to cover the additional cost:

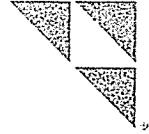
