ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR NOREEN KUBAN: Hi. I sent out an amended ordinance. They originally indicated that their investment level for Overdrive would be \$4 million for the expansion. It is now \$5 million. I just found this out at five oclock. They were making improvements to the existing building. They estimated half a million dollars. They now are indicating that they will invest \$1 million in those improvements to the existing building. That concludes what I have to say.

PRESIDENT SUSTER: Mayor, did you have anything before?

MAYOR VIC COLLOVA: The only thing I am saying is this is what we've been looking to do. Bring businesses in. That's where the tax dollars come from. When the business is paying the tax dollars that takes it off the residents packs because they are always sharing that burden so these are the kind of things we are looking at doing. In more than happy to allow these tax breaks for these companies. A company like Overdrive's salary is big. This isn'd a McDonald's. This is a big time company and they pay their employees big. This is what the city needs. I certainly would suggest that Council votes to approve.
